Special Needs Camps: Summer is an especially tough time for families with children that have developmental or physical limitations. Whether diagnosed with autism, speech/language, auditory processing or regulation difficulties. Kids Connection has developed a part-day camp that will create an environment to entice your camper.

For most of our special students, unstructured time does not create a fulfilling environment. Kids Connection will create a structured, semi-inclusive environment to meet both the physical and cognitive challenges of your camper. We will replicate a school environment with fun summer themes. This camp is great for those seeking a camp close to home, therapists part of the campers day and part-days to allow for flexibility in your schedule.

2010 SUMMER CAMPS---HOW DO I REGISTER?

- 1) **Fill out the pre-registration form** for Summer 2010 Camps; submit to Kids Connection to hold your spot. Enrollment is on a first come, first served basis.
- 2) **There are three camp sessions. Payment in full for each camp session will automatically be charged to your credit/debit as indicated below.**
- 3) **A \$20 camp deposit will be charged immediately for each camp session per camper.** The deposit(s) will hold your spot and will be applied toward the camp session fee but is not refundable if you cancel without two weeks notice. Deposits can be paid by check/credit/debit, *but remaining balances must be paid by credit/debit card only.*
- 4) Camp Cancellation: Deposits will be credited towards another camp session if TWO weeks notice is given. NO other refunds are given for camp deposits.
- 5) Ask for a complete registration kit while at Kids Connection or one can be mailed. Documents in the kit must be completed prior to camp start date. **Kids Connection, Inc. is licensed by DCFS and the documentation is required prior to program entrance. No refunds for days missed if you fail to submit proper documentation on or before the first day of camp.**
- 6) Summer camp tuition is due regardless of attendance. Attending partial camp is not acceptable.

CAMP PAYMENT OPTIONS

Submit the pre-registration form for camp with a \$20 non-refundable deposit for each camp session per camper. The deposit(s) will hold your spot and will be applied toward the camp session fee but is not refundable if you cancel without two weeks notice. Deposits can be paid by check/credit/debit, *but remaining balances must be paid by credit/debit card only.*

Camp Cancellation: Deposits will be credited towards another camp session if TWO weeks notice is given. NO other refunds are given for camp deposits.

VISA/MasterCard/Discover or debit card are the only acceptable payment options for summer camp balances. You will receive an invoice with a camp reminder notice.

Full session fee due on May 25 and June 25 and July 25 to avoid losing your camp deposit; you will receive an invoice with the amount to be debited.
